above the Aegean Sea, Erosantorini has all the trappings of a full-service resort, sans the crowds. The estate—spread over 2 acres on the Greek Isle of Santorini—accommodates groups of 14 in four suites adorned with local stone and Rubelli fabrics. Amenities include a wine cellar, an outdoor cinema, a spa, and a 115-foot infinity-edge pool (Santorini's largest). But it is the property's *philotimo*, a Greek term that roughly translates to "doing good," that makes it most extraordinary, delivering attentive service and above-and-beyond experiences. erosantorini.com (\$5,400–\$20,000) —KATHRYN ROMEYN

of private-island resorts, but last year the tropical nation welcomed something entirely new with the opening of the Four Seasons Private Island Maldives at Voavah. A first for Four Seasons, the isle is an exclusive-use haven located just minutes by speedboat from the brand's Landaa Giraavaru resort. The 5-acre property is worlds away when it comes to privacy, with no more than 22 guests enjoying access to a seven-bedroom compound with three infinity-edge pools, an overwater spa, and a beach house. The level of service you'll receive is clear from the staff-to-guest ratio: The 25 on-site experts include a marine biologist, a dive instructor, and a captain who helms the 62-foot yacht *Voavah Summer*. fourseasons.com (\$38,000–\$46,000) —Andrew Sessa
