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→ A new private mountainside estate designed by Paola Navone is quietly preparing for spring on **SANTORINI**. The four standalone suites of **Erosantorini** (www.erosantorini.com; from €5,000 per night) are

cleverly configured with courtyards and panoramic terraces to provide total privacy or be used communally. Top hospitality credentials abound: the host is a master sommelier and the chef has 20 years' experience in Athens' finest kitchens – and will bring the kids along on his morning fishing trip. The 35m infinity pool sets an island record for size – and jaw-dropping views.

→ In **CAPE TOWN**, the finishing touches are being put to the Thomas Heatherwick-designed **Zeitz Museum of Contemporary Art Africa** (www.zeitzfoundation.org), housed in the old Grain Silo, a waterfront landmark rescued from decrepitude by the
